FORMAT

Stroke Play – 13-18 year olds: 18 Holes; 7-12 year olds: 9 Holes.

MONDAY, JUNE 29

Lowest gross score for 18 holes will be the overall champion for boys and girls.

Age Divisions: In addition to the overall championship, boys and girls will compete in the following age groups: 18 holes: 17-18, 15-16 and 13-14. 9 holes: 11-12, 9-10, and 7-8. *Any tie for first place in the overall gross competition will be played off hole-by-hole until a winner is determined.*

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All contestants should register in person just outside the golf shop during the following hours:

Monday, June 29, 7 a.m. – 8 a.m.

PRACTICE AREAS

Practice areas will open one hour prior to the first starting time the day of competition. Complimentary practice balls will be available on the practice range.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met, and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

Shorts may be worn but jeans or denim shorts are not allowed. The following items are forbidden: tank tops, cut-off shorts, jogging shorts, and gym shorts. **Absolutely No Metal Spikes.**

CADDIES

A player may carry his own bag, use a pull cart or provide his own caddie. Parents, legal guardians or siblings may not caddie for competitors. Caddies must identify themselves and check in with the starter. Automotive transportation is not permitted.

STARTING TIMES

It is your responsibility to be at the starting tee early. An official clock will be present on the first and tenth tees with unofficial clocks in all practice areas. The Note to Rule 6-3 and Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I will be in effect.

PLAYER BUFFETS and FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE

The WSGA will provide lunch for each player following Play. The club will be open for beverage service beginning at 7 a.m. each day of the championship. Cash and credit card purchases are accepted throughout the facility.
